- Do you sometimes miss key words or need to ask people to repeat themselves?
- When you're in a group or in a crowded restaurant, is it difficult to follow the conversation?
- Do you often need to turn up the volume on your TV or radio?
- Is carrying on a telephone conversation difficult?
- Has someone close to you mentioned that you might have a problem with your hearing?

Answering yes to one or more of these questions may provide an early indication of some hearing impairment. A good next step is to contact Lisa and ask for a thorough hearing evaluation.
