Have you heard about Caption Call???

Are you having difficulty hearing on the telephone?? There is a phone that helps hearing impaired individuals by amplifying volume and providing written captions for calls and voicemail messages.

The requirements for installation are: a landline telephone line and a high-speed internet connection in the home.

You could receive such a telephone: that prints out your phone conversation as you're listening. Caption call is funded by FCC and a telephone is available to you **free of charge!!!**

Having trouble with inconsistent battery life or random rebooting of your hearing aids? It could be problems with your batteries. If you purchase them somewhere else, it's important to verify the voltage: it should be 1.45, not just 1.4 volts.
